Dear Ms. Brothers:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

1. Immediately below the First Aid statement and clearly distinguished from it, add "*Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.*"
2. Revise the second sentence on the front panel to read "Nursery containers formulated with Migratrol™ BPX-002 are permitted for use in the USDA RIFA Quarantine Program".
3. Under Directions for Use delete reference to the 5%/5% incorporation since the efficacy data at this time supports only the 10% incorporation.

Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
