IF IN EYES - Flush with large amount of water for 15 minutes. Seek immediate medical attention.

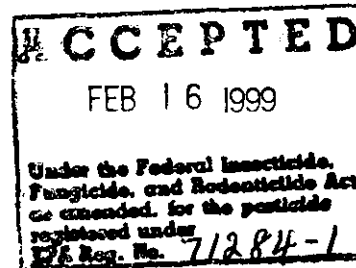
