Slip the applicator hand strap over the fingers and rub the powder into the pet's fur. Avoid getting the powder into the eyes, nose, or mouth of the pet. Apply over the entire animal otherwise. Frequent use may dry the animal's skin. If animal is badly infested apply at 3 day intervals to keep the powder dense in the fur until flea and tick population drop substantially, then reapply at two week intervals for control. Under normal infestation reapply every two weeks. Store in the recloseable bag.

Tick & Flea Flicker diatomaceous earth acts on insect physically by abrading the exterior skeleton and dehydrating the crawling pest. Insect control results from the physical qualities of DE.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Replace the applicator in the recloseable plastic bag and store in a cool, dry place.

Activate the applicator by pulling on opposite corners of the burlap bag until a slight give is noticed. Using the stick handle gently shake a barely visible trace the powder where pests may crawl: containerized food storage areas, doors and under window sills, behind stoves and refrigerators, around the edges of rooms on carpet or any flooring material and in clothing storage area surfaces.
