This equipment must be set up and operated in a manner that avoids bouncing or raising the hoods off the ground in any way. If the hoods are raised, spray particles may escape and come into contact with the crop, causing damage or destruction of the crop. The spray hoods must be operated on the ground or skimming across the ground. Tractor speed must be adjusted to avoid bouncing of the spray hoods. Avoid operation on rough or sloping ground where

the spray hoods might be raised off the ground.

Follow these requirements:

- •The spray hoods must be operated on the ground or skimming across the ground.
- •Leave at least an 8 inch untreated strip over the drill row. For example, if the crop row width is 38 inches, the maximum width of the spray hood should be 30 inches
- •Maximum tractor speed: 5 mph.
- •Maximum wind speed: 10 mph
- •Use low-drift nozzles.
