DILUTION RATES

Use the following dilution rates when applying BlightBan C9-1 for fire blight control. Use the coverage characteristics of the application equipment and plant size to determine the volume of water. Spray solution should be used within 48 hours of mixing. Standard municipal chlorinated water does not significantly reduce viability.

CONCENTRATE:

50 to 150 gallons per acre 200 to 350 gallons per acre

FIRE BLIGHT REDUCTION

BlightBan C9-1 should be used in an integrated fire blight control program. BlightBan C9-1 improves control with any existing antibiotic spray program. As an aid in the control of fire blight in pears and apples, select one of the application methods below. When applied as a concentrate spray, using either method, better control is obtained when using a minimum of 100 gallons of water per acre.

Method 1: Apply 5 ounces (150 grams) as a concentrate or 7 ounces (200 grams) as a dilute spray. The first application should be made at 15 to 20% bloom followed by a second application at first petal fall-full bloom, and a third application at "rattail" bloom for pear or post petal fall for apples.

Method 2: Apply 2.5 ounces (75 grams) as a concentrate or 3.5 ounces (100 grams) as a dilute spray. Apply to alternate rows with the first application at 15 to 20% bloom followed by a second application to the untreated rows one week later. Make the second and third applications using the same rates, applied to alternating rows at first petal fall-full bloom. For the final two applications, use the same rates and method for the final applications and apply at "rattail" bloom for pear or post petal fall for apples.

Compatibility: Do not tank mix with ziram, mancozeb, maneb or copper-based compounds. BlightBan C9-1 is compatible with streptomycin, Terramycin®, Rovral®, and Benlate®. Copper sprays or copper dust applications are incompatible with the performance of this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep container unopened until use. Store unused product in original container. This product should be stored at temperatures between -4°F and 40°F (frozen or refrigerated) for long-term storage. This product may be stored at room temperature not to exceed 70°F for one week prior to use. Keep out of reach of children and animals

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Offer bag for recycling, if available. Then dispose of bag in a sanitary landfill, by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
