
3. Product specific efficacy data will be required once the efficacy guidelines are in place. You will be notified of the efficacy requirements when the efficacy guidelines are published.

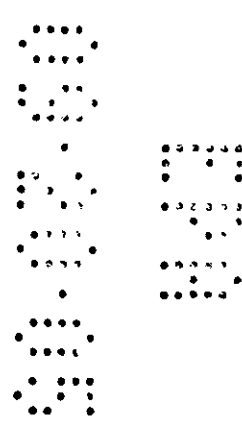
