- e. Delete the graphic, Flame Symbol, from the product labeling.
- f. Revise your Precautionary Statements section to read:

Precautionary Statement
Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals
Keep Out of Reach of Children

Caution. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Use in well ventilated areas. Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

g. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment section to read:

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes wit plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

- h. Change the signal word from Warning to Caution.
- I. Change the product descriptor just below the Directions for Use heading to read:

Spiriclens Spray is designed for use in the pharmaceutical industry. It is effective as a disinfectant on hard inanimate environmental surfaces in insolators, cleanrooms, sterile areas, and also on tools and equipment prior to introduction into these areas. Effective against vegetative bacteria.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Spiriclens® Spray is designed for effective disinfection of hard surfaces such as worktops, equipment, and components in sterile/aseptic manufacturing and processing areas. Effective against vegetative microorganisms.

To Disinfect Hard Surfaces, Equipment and Components:

Surfaces must be free from organic soiling prior to disinfection. For soiled surfaces, a precleaning step is required. Use a clean sponge or lint-free cloth. On precleaned surfaces, hold can upright and spray the surface from a distance of 8 inches for 3 to 4 seconds to ensure an even coverage. Allow the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

CAUTION

Causes eye irritation. Do not spray near or get in eyes. Use in well ventilated areas. Harmful if swallowed. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of eye contact flush eyes immediately with plenty of water. Get medical assistance if irritation persists. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Pressurized
