Food Handling Establishments: Places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or served.

Nonfood/feed Areas: May be used to manufacture end-use products for use as a general spot or crack and crevice treatment in nonfood areas. Similar areas where insects hide or through which insects may enter can be treated. Examples of nonfood areas include garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Food/Feed Areas: May not be used to manufacture products for use in food/feed areas.
