On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.


This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. **Make the following labeling changes:**
  - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 71532-11".
  - b) Revise the First Aid statements according to PR Notice 2001-1. Please note that based on the acute toxicity of this product the "If Swallowed" statements should precede all other First Aid statements.
    - The "If swallowed" statements should read: *"Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person"*.

- The "If in eyes" statements should read: *"Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice"*.
  - Revise the first bullet of the "If on skin or clothing" statements as follows: *"Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes"*. Revise the last bullet as follows: *"Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice"*.
  - The "If inhaled" statements should read: *"Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice"*.
  - At the bottom of the First Aid box, and preceding the Note to Physician, add the following statements: *"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical treatment information"*. Please refer to PR Notice 2001-6 section III (I) and (J) for details.
  - A Note to Physician is not required for this product. Please note that inducing vomiting is no longer recommended as a standard first aid instruction. If you wish to include a Note to Physician, please refer to PR Notice 2001-6 sections IV for details.
- c) Revise the Precautionary statements to read *"May be fatal if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Contact with the product may cause transient tingling and reddening of the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse"*.
- d) Under Limitations of Liability revise the statement beginning with: *"In no case shall LG International be liable..."* to read: *"To the extent permitted by law LG International shall not be liable..."*. As currently written the statement negates and/or detracts from labeling requirements as set forth by the Agency in 40 CFR Part 156, and is, therefore, considered misbranding.
3. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
