

FIRST AID PROCEDURE

(Meets Federal Specification TT-W-572B)

COBRA WRAP™ containing copper naphthenate is intended for use only on poles, posts and pilings as a wood preservative treatment. COBRA WRAP™ containing copper naphthenate provides protection against moisture, fungal rot and termite damage. This copper naphthenate wood preservative and insecticide will preserve, protect and seal wood surfaces that will be in contact with soil or concrete. Depending upon climatic conditions, species of wood to which applied, moisture and humidity, treatment extends service life several years.

PREPARATION AND APPLICATION

Wood should be clean, dry, well seasoned and free of bark. When using COBRA WRAP™ as a groundline treatment excavate around wood to allow top of wrap to extend 2" above groundline.

Protect eyes and skin from contact.

Wire brush area 3" above groundline and approximately 20" below groundline removing dirt and decayed material.

Cut off sufficient length of COBRARAP™ leaving 2" - 6" (5cm - 15cm) of wrap to serve as overlap. Lay on ground exposing the pouches of preservative. Peel off top layer exposing the sealable layer below. On the overlap portion leave a sufficient tail attached to the outermost edge forcing preservative to move back into wood zone for penetration.

Wrap proper length COBRA WRAP™ around the pole with saturated pad against the pole and staple or tack firmly in place. Staple short side of the backing first and overlap with longer edge. Allow wrap to extend 2" above groundline.

Backfill excavation, tamping firmly.

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
