 - e. The Environmental Hazards section of the label:

"This product is toxic to wildlife, fish, and aquatic invertebrates. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters or effluent. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge.
