- e. Under Directions for Use change the "Adjust pH between 7.2-7.8" to read: change pH between 7.2-7.6" and "20-30 ppm" to read "30-40 ppm".
- f. Revise the reentry level to read: Reentry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm of chlorine due to risk of bodily harm.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

This product is part of the *DuPont™* [Simple] Pool Care Weekly Care System

DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care Sanitizer [3"] [1"] Chlorinating Tablets is a concentrated form of stabilized chlorine. This products is designed for use with chlorine feeders and will dissolve slowly and uniformly to deliver free chlorine sanitizer to pool water.

When used as directed, this product is an effective swimming pool disinfectant and sanitizer. The dosage required to maintain sanitary water will vary depending upon water temperature, bather load, exposure to windblown debris, rain storms and length of filtration cycle.

## **Getting Started**

- Ensure all pool equipment is working properly.
- Backwash the filter system following manufacturer's directions.
- Adjust the alkalinity of the water to 100-150 ppm using DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care Total Alkalinity Increaser
- Adjust pH to between 7.2-7.8 using DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care pH Increaser Or pH
  Deceaser
- Add DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care Chlorine Stabilizer to establish a minimum level of 20-30 ppm. Sunlight will reduce the chlorine sanitizer level. Stabilizer will minimize the sun's ability to breakdown the chlorine, and allow the level to be more easily maintained.
- Test for metals. If metals are present, add *DuPont™* [Simple] Pool Care Metal Remover to prevent staining of pool surface due to metals.
- When using other products as outlined in the directions for this product, always follow directions on those products.

#### [Directions for sanitizer maintenance with 3" (8 oz) tablets

Place one tablet per 10,000 gallons of pool water into a suitable chlorine feeder, floater or skimmer dispenser. Continue to add the tablets as required to maintain a free chlorine sanitizer residual of 1-4 ppm as determined by the use of *DuPont™* [Simple] Pool Care Test Strips. Regular use of test strips is necessary to determine the number of tablets and the frequency of additions required to maintain 1-4 ppm free chlorine at all times.

Never add **DuPont™** [Simple] Pool Care Sanitizer 3" Chlorinating Tablets directly into the swimming pool as bleaching or fading of pool liner or pool finish may occur.

Add 7 ounces (14 tablets) of 1" tablets per 10,000 gallons of pool water into a suitable chlorine feeder, floater or skimmer dispenser. Continue to add the tablets as required to maintain a free chlorine sanitizer residual of 1-4 ppm as determined by the use of *DuPont™* [Simple] Pool Care Test Strips. Regular use of test strips is necessary to determine the number of tablets and the frequency of additions required to maintain 1-4 ppm free chlorine at all times.

Never add **DuPont™** [Simple] Pool Care Sanitizer 1" Chlorinating Tablets directly into the swimming pool as bleaching or fading of pool liner or pool finish may occur.

#### ADD ALGAECIDE WEEKLY

A weekly addition of DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care Algaecide will help keep the pool clear of algae. Add 4 oz of DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care Algaecide for every 10000 gallons of pool water weekly.
