



When used as directed, this product is an effective swimming pool disinfectant and sanitizer. The dosage required to maintain sanitary water will vary depending upon water temperature, bather load, exposure to windblown debris, rain storms and length of filtration cycle.

Getting Started

- Ensure all pool equipment is working properly.
- Backwash the filter system following manufacturer's directions.
- Adjust the alkalinity of the water to 100-150 ppm using DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care Total Alkalinity Increaser
- Adjust pH to between 7.2-7.6 using DuPont™ [Simple] Pool Care pH Increaser Or pH
 Deceaser

REENTRY
