- 2. Change EPA File symbol 71654-RG to EPA Registration Number 71654-13.
- 3. Under Physical and Chemical hazards move the left bracket to the beginning of the second sentence at the Environmental Hazards statement.
- 4. Under Directions for Use, change last sentence of third paragraph to read "Proper sanitary practices require changing spa water at a minimum of every 30 days and properly monitoring water conditions."
- 5. In first paragraph under Getting Started change first sentence to read "Before initially using DuPont Spa Care Sanitizer Brominating Tablets in your spa or hot tub, add 1.5 ounces DuPont Spa Care Start Up (sodium bromide) for every 300 gallons of spa water to establish a 30 ppm bromide concentration."
- 6. Delete last sentence under Oxidize After Every Use heading.
- 7. Submit one copy of the final printed label for the record.

When used as directed, DuPont™ Spa Care Sanitizer Brominating Tablets will disinfect and sanitize spa and hot tub water, keeping it clean, clear and free of odor. [DuPont™ Spa Care Sanitizer Brominating Tablets gives the effectiveness of chlorine without the chlorine odor.] Proper sanitary practices require changing spa water at a minimum of every 80 days. and properly monitoring water ditions.

**Getting Started** 

- Clean all surfaces
- Clean the filter system with DuPont™ Spa Care Cartridge Filter Cleaner following manufacturer's directions.
- Adjust the calcium hardness and the total alkalinity of the water using DuPont™ Spa Care Calcium Hardness Increaser and DuPont™ Spa Care pH and Alkalinity Increaser.
- Adjust pH to between 7.2-7.8 using DuPont™ Spa Care pH and Alkalinity Increaser or pH Decreaser.
- When using other products as outlined in the directions for this product, always follow label directions on those products.
