STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

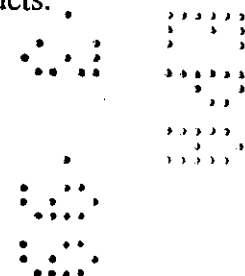
