Wear goggles. Or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

4. Revise the "Statement Of Practical Treatment" to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Hold lids open and flush with steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

It is recommended that the following appear separate from, but in close proximity to the statement of practical treatment:


NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**For Dairy and Food Processing Equipment,
Tanks, Tank trucks, Silos, Vats, Pails,
Pipelines and Closed Systems:** Prior to use of
this product, remove gross food particles and
soil by a pre-flush, or pre-scrape and, when
necessary, presoak treatment from all surfaces.
Then wash with detergent or other cleaning
solution followed by a thorough potable water
rinse. Sanitize using a solution of 1 fluid
ounce CS- 100 Acid Anionic Sanitizer in 5
gallons of water. All surfaces should be
exposed to the sanitizing solution for a period
of not less than 2 minutes. Drain thoroughly.

NOTE: FOR MECHANICAL OPERATIONS
prepared us solution may not be reused for
sanitizing but may be reused for other purposes
such as cleaning.

FOR MANUAL OPERATIONS fresh
sanitizing solution should be prepared as soon
as they become diluted or soiled.
