

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Under the subheading entitled "**Only for formulation into a herbicide for:**" on the second (2) page of your product labeling, revise item 2 to read as the following for the purpose of clarification: "This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on this label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s)."
2. Please submit one (1) final printed copy of the referenced label, incorporating the above change, before releasing the product for shipment. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
