Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Postemergence Layby

For best results, use ET herbicide in a tank mixtures with other labeled herbicides for control of annual or perennial herbaceous broadleaf and grass weeds less than 6" in height, or rosettes less than 3" in diameter. If grassy weeds are present, use ET herbicide in tank mixtures with glyphosate or MSMA. For broadleaf weed control use mixtures of ET with glyphosate, diuron or other labeled products. Thorough, uniform spray coverage is essential for good control. This tank mixture may be applied as a late postemergence treatment when the cotton crop has attained an average height of 18 inches or more than 3 inches stem bark development at the base of the plant. **Avoid contact of the herbicide with desirable vegetation.** ET herbicide and tank mixtures may be used in place of tillage for weed control.

Allow a minimum of 30 days between preplant burndown application of ET herbicide and postemergence application. For crops not listed on this label, applications must be made at least 30 days prior to planting. For tank mixtures, refer to each product label for crop rotation restrictions, mixing directions, and precautionary statements. Always use in accordance with the most restrictive product label.


