

Non-bearing tree fruit, nut, and vine crops	Control of annual grasses and broadleaf weeds	0.5 to 2.0 fl oz/A plus labeled rate of glyphosate product or other herbicide	Use the higher rate and spray volume for control of larger weeds (4 to 6" tall). Weeds larger than 6" tall may not be controlled. Do not harvest edible crops for 12 months following application.
	Control of broadleaf weeds	0.5 to 2.0 fl oz/A plus labeled rate of 2,4D or other herbicide	

**Use Restrictions**

- Do not make more than 3 applications or exceed 5.5 fl oz/A during the growing season.
- Allow a minimum of 30 days between applications.
- For tank mixtures, refer to each product label for crop rotation restrictions, mixing directions, and precautionary statements. Follow the crop rotation statements on the tankmix product, if applicable and they are more restrictive.
- Addition of labeled residual herbicides to extend weed control is permissible.
- Do not allow livestock to graze in treated areas.

**This label must be in the possession of the user at time of application.**

**All applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA registered labels are to be followed.**
