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3. Place the following "Note to Physician" in the "First Aid" section of the label:

"Note to Physician

4. Revise the Ingredients Statement to state the following: "Active Ingredient" and "Inert Ingredient", deleting the plural form of ingredient in each case.

5. Revise label to state "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" deleting "the".


6. In the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section revise the heading "Storage" to read "Pesticide Storage".

7. Revise the statement which begins "For the formulation of pesticide products used..." to read "For the formulation of antimicrobial products used..."

HAZARD TO HUMAN & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER
