Dear Mr. Sargent:

On February 25, 2011, you wrote to request amendment of the referenced pesticide product registration to a) reflect its formulation from a recently registered source product, b) become solely a manufacturing-use product though removal of end-use product use directions (per the Agency's letter of November 29, 2007; S. K. Reilly to G. Sargent), and c) change the product name from SUBTILIX® Biological Fungicide to SUBTILIX® MUP. In support of the requests, you submitted a new Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF, EPA Form 8570-4) and a draft product label. On July 8, 2011, an updated draft label for EPA Reg. No. 71840-1 was provided in response our July 1, 2011 email request. The Biopesticides and Pollution Prevention Division (BPPD) reviewed the submission and update, and a summary of our conclusions is presented below. Please also consult the enclosed memorandum (J. L. Kough to D. Greenway; June 24, 2011).

The product name has been changed, as requested, to become SUBTILIX® MUP.

The February 25, 2011 CSF for EPA Reg. No. 71840-1, showing a registered source for the active ingredient, is acceptable.

The label revision referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you submit two copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for further description of final printed labeling.
