This product contains a sodium chlorite mixture which, when contacted with chlorine, generates chlorine dioxide. CD-Cartridge is for use by industrial sites where sterility conditions are critical for optimal performance. Use CD-Cartridge to sterilize manufacturing and laboratory equipment, environmental surfaces and implements, such as: manufacturing vessels; beakers, test tubes and laboratory glassware; "clean rooms"; sterility testing isolators and pharmaceutical isolators.

This product is for use in Advanced Sterilzation Product's Chlorine Dioxide Gas Generator (CD-Generator) ONLY and must be used by trained personnel. For proper generation and application of chlorine dioxide, you must follow the instructions in the ASP Chlorine Dioxide Gas Generator Users Manual.
