

Remove one ThermaCELL® Mosquito Repellent mat from wrapper, insert the mat under the appliance's grill. One mat lasts up to 4 hours. Mat turns from pale blue to white when active ingredient has been exhausted.





Remove the butane cartridge cap. Screw the cartridge into the opening of the appliance; the butane gas will begin to flow. Make sure the cartridge is fully inserted by turning it clockwise until it stops.


