EPA Reg. No. 71910-2 Submission dated 10/16/06

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

The mood lamp with any color feature has been determined to be an attractive nuisance. You must delete from the label all marketing claims for and directions for use as a mood lamp.

Clarify the site "porches" to be porches which are not an enclosed space.

The butane cartridges net contents must be listed as fluid ounces.

Clarify the net contents of the butane cartridges. While the first page of the master label provides only one net contents for the cartridge, elsewhere in the label reference is made to different size cartridges.

Graphics must exclude pictures of children and food.

The use of a securing device for the appliance (device to secure the appliance to a stable horizontal surface) is acceptable. The term "holster" is associated with what people wear on their belts or otherwise attach to their bodies and is not acceptable. You must use another term not associated with things people wear. As a condition of registration,

within 60 days you must submit documentation that this securing device is constructed of non-flammable material.

Add to the directions for use of all appliances, including the securing device, the following:

Do not attach this appliance to your body or clothing.

Tolerances relating to allethrins have been revoked. Revise all directions about not contaminating food to read as follows:

Cover or remove all exposed food.

In directions for use with the securing device, revise the sentence about covering the grill to read as follows:

Do not cover the grill.

On item 6 of the directions for use with the securing device, delete the language about inserting the spare cartridge and mats in the side pouches, as it detracts from the physical and chemical hazards statements.

Delete the direction for use on a tree limb. This detracts from the directions to use on a horizontal, stable surface.

Delete the claim "no messy wax candles to drip or spill" as this is a comparative claim.

Delete the claims about mosquito and bug-free comfort, as this implies 100% efficacy.

All label claims other than 4 hours per mat must show the user how they are calculated. The master label's use of the brackets {} & [] is ambiguous, and may be interpreted to mean that the user will not know how duration of repellency claims are calculated. In addition, the label must clarify what the term "up to" means when used with duration claims.

Delete the expression "no cause for concern" in the claims about vapor. This detracts from the precautionary statements.

This is an insecticide product. Delete from the directions for use or marketing claims the following, which detract from the precautionary statements:

Lamp may be used as just a lamp.

Repellent and light can be used together or separately.

Use the lamp just for light.

Revise the disposal claims to include used mats.

Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapors.

Move the following statements from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals Statements to a section entitled "Use Restrictions" in the Directions for Use: Only for outdoor use as an insect repellent. Do not use indoors, in tents or in any enclosed area. Do not insert anything other than [product name] mats into the appliance [lamp].

Move the following statements to the Physical and Chemical Hazards Statements: Do not touch the grill while the appliance [lamp] is in use. The grill is hot while in use.

Move the following statements from the Physical and Chemical Hazards Statements to the "Use Restrictions" in the Directions for Use:

Place appliance [lamp] on a flat, stable surface with the grill facing upward. Clean with a damp cloth only when the appliance [lamp] is cool and inactive.

Move to the following language from Physical and Chemical hazards to the Use Restrictions:

Butane cartridges other than Thermacell cartridges will not work in this appliance [lamp]. Seller will not be held responsible for damage, injury or poor performance caused by use of other butane cartridges or repellent mats.

Revise the Physical and Chemical Hazard statements to delete the separate heading for for butane cartridge.

Revise the cartridge label to include the heading "Physical and Chemical Hazards"

The butane cartridge label must bear the EPA Reg. No. and EPA Establishment No., the signal word Caution and the statement Keep Out of Reach of Children and a statement referring the user to the accompanying label.

The Caution signal word must be limited to the inhalation hazard. To call attention to the hot surface concern, you must use another word such as attention or alert.

The appliance and lamps must also bear the following information: the EPA registration number and establishment number. The Signal word Caution and the statement Keep out of Reach of Children must be placed so that they are visible when the appliance or lamp is in use.

Delete the following claim which detracts from the label precautions and directions for use:

Easily fits in a backpack, purse or small bag.

Delete the following comparative claims:

No candle, no messy wax No messy sprays or lotions Without sprays or lotions The repellent you don't have to put on apply to your skin New lamp provides x% more light than an ordinary candle.

Delete all claims that any device or feature is new. These products have been registered for many years.

Delete or submit as an amendment justification for odor free claims and claims about not spooking game.

Delete protection claims as they imply 100% efficacy.

Delete all zone and cell claims as they imply 100% efficacy.

Delete fishing, as this detracts from the environmental hazards statements.

Delete "gets rid of", "drives away", "bug free", "no bite", and "no fly" as these imply 100% efficacy.

Delete references to barbecues, outdoor dining and picnics or qualify them to include the statement "Cover or remove all exposed food."

Delete the references to little league games or qualify it to include the statement Keep Out of Reach of Children.

Delete the securing device claims the statement that it provides storage for extra cartridge and mat, for the reasons already stated.

Delete from the securing device claims any claims that it may be secured to "most objects", "tree branch" or "almost any object," and that it is "the no hands way to transport." These claims detract from the directions for use which state that it must be secured to a stable horizontal surface.

Delete from the marketing claims the following, which are vague and may lead to misuse:

Can be taken anywhere

Etc.

Other recreational areas.

Delete or explain on the label what is meant by "passive".

Clarify on the label that the promotional language "The World's Best Bird Feeders" does not permit use on bird feeders.

Attached is a summary of additional concerns which Schawbel must address within 60 days.

Thermacell Mosquito Repellent

- 1. As discussed in the meeting of 1/18/07, the Mood Lamp has been determined to be an attractive nuisance. Within 60 days you must submit a plan for phasing out mood lamps.
- 2. The notice of registration is hereby amended to limit this registration to mosquito repellent pads used with applicances or lamps which rely on butane cartridges for elution of the active ingredient. Any appliance or lamp which uses another means of elution of the active ingredient must be submitted as a new registration.
- 3. Within 60 days, you must submit a table which lists all the appliances, lamps or devices which are part of this registration by model numbers and which includes the following:
 - a. Picture of the device
 - b. Whether the device replies on vaporization technology or flame with metal plate
 - c. Whether the device is self start or uses a match/lighter
 - d. Whether the device has an automatic shut off
 - e. For lamps, is the light provided by flame or by battery powered conventional or LED lights
 - f. Features which reduce potential for accidents
 - g. Where the labeling is located.
 - h. Submit or cite the efficacy data supporting the repellency claims for the pests listed on this product's label. You must document how the release rate (elution rate) for each device is equivalent (or not) to the original efficacy data.
- 4. Submit any incidents associated with the product falling into water bodies.
- 5. Any design change will require an amendment and must include the items identified in #3 above.
