Dear Mr. Rodgers:

In response to your request of March 16, 2001 the labeling referred to in the subject heading above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is accepted with conditions cited below.

In accordance with Pesticide Registration (PR) Notice 2001-1 the Statement of Practical Treatment or First Aid Statements must be revised as follows. Please provide an emergency contact phone number, a toll free number if possible. If not available, you may use the National Pesticide Telecommunications Network as listed below.

First Aid	
If in eyes	<ul> <li>Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.</li> <li>Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.</li> <li>Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.</li> </ul>
If on skin or clothing	<ul> <li>Take off contaminated clothing.</li> <li>Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.</li> <li>Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.</li> </ul>
If inhaled	<ul> <li>If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible.</li> <li>Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.</li> </ul>

If swallowed

- Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
