

To Mix:

- **First, shake dry powder.**
- **Add 48 oz water (6 Cups)**
- **Shake well for 30 seconds**
- **Pour into sharps container**
- **Press cap securely onto sharp's container**
- **Hold top and bottom of sharp's container, shaking while inverting continuously for at least 30 seconds.**

After following directions thoroughly, place both containers in box. Store for 24 hours. Box and containers may then be disposed in standard waste receptacle.

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: DANGER: Highly Corrosive. Causes Skin and Eye Damage. May be Fatal if Swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not handle with bare hands. Wear goggles or face shield and use rubber gloves and only thoroughly clean dry utensils when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust and fumes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Pour the thoroughly mixed contents of solidification compound container into disposal container until full. Press cap on securely and mix for at least 30 seconds by holding the top and bottom of sharps container, shaking while inverting continuously until thoroughly mixed. Place both containers into box and store in a Safe isolated place for 24 hours. After following all directions thoroughly, the box with both containers may be disposed in standard waste receptacle.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Read before using. Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before discarding this container. IF SPILLED, use rubber gloves and carefully return sharps and other spilled materials to sharps disposal container. Immediately commence standard disposal procedure (See Direction for Use). Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal or cleaning of equipment.
