Dear Mr. Folkins:

The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10, dated May 1, 2012, for "XT-2000 Orange Oil Plus," EPA Reg. No. 71986-2.

The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the changes requested fall within the scope of PRN 98-10. **The label submitted with your application has been stamped "Notification," and the alternate brand name "Power Plant" has been added to the product record.**

Please be aware that should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. **In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process.** Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website may be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.


As of May 2, 2012, the following claims on the website "<http://www.xt2000.com/>" were found to be substantially different from those approved through the registration process:

1. "XT-2000 Orange Oil **natural organic cure** to termite problems."
2. "Go **Green**, Go Orange."
3. "Child & Pet Friendly. **Natural organic** ingredients ensure **safety for the entire family.**"
4. "XT-2000 Orange Oil is hard on termites, but **easy on the planet's resources.**"
5. "XT-2000 Orange Oil Plus provides an **immediate kill** because of it's [sic] ability to travel...."

Claims 1, 2, 3, and 4 are considered to be implied environmental and health safety claims. Claim 5 is considered to be a heightened efficacy claim, and is not supported by the efficacy data submitted under this registration. The Agency considers these statements to be potentially false and misleading. Therefore, you must remove them from your website. Please notify the Agency when you have done so.

Structural Drywood Termite Infestation:

Applicator must locate termite galleries. Tapping on wood with screwdriver and listening for different sounds that would indicate variations in wood density may help locate galleries.

Wood Boring Beetle Infestation:

Applicator must locate beetle infestation. Typically apply POWER PLANT at a rate of 1 ounce per square foot or until surface is thoroughly wet. When applying to furniture or finished wood treat by injecting Power Plant directly into the holes using the injector provided. Be sure to wipe off excess to preserve the finish.

Carpenter Ant Infestation

Locate areas of damage and treat by directly spr and injecting through damages. Immediately wipe excess.

Retreatment:

Re-apply as necessary to eradicate infestation.
