

Use anytime weeds and grasses are actively growing. Treated weeds usually show initial symptoms within hours and complete kill in 1 to 2 weeks. Larger more established weeds may take up to 4 weeks for a complete kill. Roundup works best in warm sunny weather with daytime temperature above 60° F. Reapply if it rains within 2 hours after application. If hard-to-control weeds are not killed within 4 weeks, reapply.

### WHEN TO APPLY

- Apply when weeds are actively growing. Use anytime weeds (and/& grasses) are actively growing.
- For best results apply during warm sunny weather (above 60° F).
- Spray/Apply when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable plants.
- Roundup is RAIN-PROOF™ in 2 hours. Rainfall 2 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness. (or) RAIN-PROOF Rain or watering 2 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness.
- Apply when weeds are small and/& before seeds form.) Weeds yellow and wilt within hours with complete kill in 1 to 2 weeks. Weeds usually begin to wilt within hours with complete kill in 1 to 2 weeks. Established weeds may require a repeat application.
- All ornamental flowers, trees & shrubs may be planted 1 day after application. Treated weeds usually show symptoms within 24 hours with complete kill in 1-2 weeks. Larger, more established weeds may take up to 4 weeks for a complete kill. Roundup works best in warm sunny weather with daytime temperatures above 60°F. Reapply if it rains within 2 hours after application or if regrowth occurs.

To treat individual weeds adjust the nozzle to a coarse spray. Spray when air is calm. Position sprayer tip approximately 1-2 feet from weeds and apply until completely covered.

IMPORTANT: Roundup is an all-purpose weed and grass killer which will kill almost all plants contacted. If necessary, use cardboard or plastic to shield desirable plants. If plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse off immediately with water. Do NOT use for spot weed control in lawns since Roundup kills all green plants, including lawn grass.

Sprayed areas can be replanted with ornamentals or flowers the/ 1 day after treatment.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

Adjust nozzle to a coarse spray.
 [for PNS] - Adjust nozzle to deliver narrow or wide spray.
 Spray the weeds or grasses you want to kill until thoroughly wet.

[Instructions for Pull 'N Spray]

- Adjust nozzle on wand to deliver a narrow or wide spray. Pull up on handle DO NOT PUMP. Spray the weeds or grasses you want to kill until thoroughly wet.
- When spot treating weeds in a flower or vegetable garden, shield desirable plants from drift with a sheet (piece) of cardboard or plastic. If desirable plant is accidentally sprayed, rinse off immediately with water.

[Instructions for Edger Applicator] Remove top cap.

Tighten the built-in sprinkler applicator.

To use as an edger:

- Turn jug upside down.
- Walk slowly holding jug 2 6 inches above the ground or weeds.
- Apply product to thoroughly cover unwanted vegetation.
- One gallon will cover a band 2 inches wide and 1200 feet long.

To control weeds in larger areas, such as brick or gravel walks and patios:

- Turn jug upside down.
- Hold jug about waist high to apply.
- Adjust the width of the spray pattern to cover weeds by raising or lowering the jug.

**IMPORTANT**: Do not spray plants or grasses you like - they may die too. Not recommended for spot weed control in lawns since Roundup kills lawn grasses.

## WHERE TO USE (or) ADDITIONAL TIPS

For General Weed Control: Use along fences, paths, patios, sidewalks and driveways, around trees, shrubs, and ornamental plantings and flower beds, around buildings, and in brick and gravel walkways. Use to trim and edge landscape areas. Do NOT use for spot weed control in lawns since Roundup kills all green plants, including lawn grass.

For Spot Spráying: Use on actively growing weeds in and around flower beds, ornamental trees, fruit and nut trees, grapevines, shrubs, fences, driveways and walkways. Spray when air is calm. Make sure Roundup does not contact the leaves, green stems, or exposed roots of plants you don't want to kill. If necessary, use cardboard or plastic to shield plants. For Landscaping: Use to prepare areas for planting of ornamentals, trees, shrubs, desert landscapes, rock gardens, flower beds or similar plantings. Treated areas can be replanted 1 day after treatment.

For Wildlife Areas: Use to prepare areas for planting wildlife food. Exotic or undesirable plants can be controlled to allow for planting or recovery of native plant species. Spot treatments can be made to selectively remove unwanted plants. Be careful to keep spray off desirable plants.

### For Lawn Renovation (Or) Replacement

- Use Roundup to kill lawn and weeds before planting new lawn (or)

- Skip one mowing before spraying. (or)
- Do not mow for 7 days before or after treatment.
- If green patches remain after 7 days, reapply. (or)
- Wait 7 days after (the last) application to rake, till or plant with seed or sod.
   (or)
  - After 7 days, prepare the soil for planting by raking or rototilling the lawn. (or)
- Rake up and remove loosened thatch or debris.
- Mix in starter fertilizer and other amendments, if needed. Level the soil.
- Apply seed according to directions on seed package, or install sod. Grass seed must have a good contact with soil to germinate and grow.
- Keep area moist for 2 weeks, to establish new lawn, then water as needed.

#### To Kill Vines

If vine is growing up a pole, fence or mature tree trunk, cut vine to a height of 3 to 4 feet and spray to thoroughly cover remaining vine. If vine is climbing a shrub or immature (green) tree trunk, to avoid damage to these plants, cut vine at base and spray its regrowth. Shield shrub and green trunk from spray drift with a sheet of cardboard or plastic. (or)

If vines are growing up poles, fences, or tree trunks with mature bark, cut vines to a height of 3 to 4 ft and spray vines thoroughly. If vines are climbing shrubs, or tree trunks with green bark, cut vines at base and spray regrowth. Shield shrubs and green bark from spray drift with a sheet of cardboard or plastic.

For Brush Control: Use when brush is green and growing. If plants are taller than 5 feet, cut back and spray regrowth. Brush sprayed in the fall may not be fully controlled until the following season. Hard-to-control species such as Blackberry, Kudzu, or Poison Oak may require a second application.

**Stump Treatment:** Stumps can be treated to prevent regrowth. For best results, treat when the vegetation is actively growing and within 5 minutes of being cut down.

- Cut the stump close to the soil surface.
- Drive 4-5 nail holes into the stump.
- · Flood the stump with undiluted product.

This treatment will control or suppress many types of woody brush and trees, such as alder, bluegum eucalyptus, madrone, oak, giant reed, saltcedar, sweetgum, and tan oak.

#### RE-SEEDING AND REPLANTING IN SPRAYED AREAS

Ornamentals and Flowers - May be reseeded or replanted the next day.

**Vegetables -** To plant listed vegetables, wait 3 days after spraying, before seeding or transplanting. For tomato transplants or unlisted vegetables, wait 30 days after spraying. (or) \*Note: Tomatoes planted from seed only. Wait 30 days for rooted transplants.
