- b. The master label is identified as "**RD 1649 Herbicide Master Label**"! Various information throughout the labeling pertain to herbicides and not insecticides. Delete all references -statements/claims not pertinent to this product (i.e., delete all information regarding herbicides).
- c. Page 1, Front Panel, Ingredient Statement:
Include the active ingredient CAS # (68359-37-5).
- d. Since this product is a 100% re-pack of the cited product, you need to include the inert ingredient disclosure statement.
- e. Page 2, Back Panel, Product Facts box:
Revise statements above pests list as follows:
- Change "protects for weeks." to ... "**protects for up to 2 weeks or 14 days.**"
 - Change "For use outdoors on ... trees, ..." to "For use outdoors on ... **small trees, ...**".
- f. Directions for Use:
- Page 3: Under "How Often to Use", change ... "killing for weeks." to ... "**killing for up to 2 weeks or 14 days.**"
 - Page 4: Change "Trees" to "**Small Trees**" in the sub-title "Flower, Trees, ... Covers".
 - Page 5: You may move the "For Best Results" box to the end of "Directions for Use", and before the "Storage and Disposal" box. Thus, the statements under "For Best Results" would be applicable to the "Lawn Pests" use.
- g. Note to Physician:
Add the following "**No specific antidote is available. Treat the patient symptomatically**".
- h. Appendix 1.
- Either delete or explain "**Fast Aid Technology**".

Illustration # 1

- Remove sprayer from [Insert location] and unwrap hose completely.
