Remove safety tab from nozzle by pressing towards control knob snapping it off. Turn the control knob to the ON position to begin spraying. If you desire to spray water only, turn the control knob to the WATER position, to bypass the product. When finished, turn the control knob to the OFF position. Turn faucet to OFF position. Discharge residual water pressure by turning control knob to the WATER position and then OFF again.

Diluted product covers approximately 4,000 sq. ft.

NOTE: The following "Directions for Use" will be used for product packaged in all containers other then the "ready-to-spray hose-end 1 quart container":

Shake or mix well. Add 16 oz. of **Goose Repellent Concentrate** for each gallon of water and thoroughly mix. With garden sprayer or sprinkler, apply diluted product liberally to landscaping, lawns, or turf areas during a dry period. Re-apply as needed.

Diluted product covers approximately 16,000 sq. ft. per gallon of product.
