

- c. Safety claims of pesticides, or its ingredients are not acceptable on pesticide product labeling. Therefore, you must delete the term "Safe" from the label.
- d. The statement "Guaranteed Superior Performance" is considered a comparison claim and without data to demonstrate superior performance when compared to other similar or identical product is misleading. Therefore, the statement must be deleted from the label.
- e. The ingredient statement must be displayed on the label as follows:

Copper Sulfate Pentahydrate*	11.8%
INERT (or Others) INGREDIENTS	<u>88.2%</u>
TOTAL	100.0%

[*Copper as elemental 3.0%]


- f. The child signal word "CAUTION" and the "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" statement must be listed immediately below the ingredient statement.
- g. On the back panel, delete the statement "Works better and does more than other algaecides" "the best algae prevention and remover product money can buy" are comparison claims. Data was not submitted to support the claims. Therefore, the claims must be deleted from the label.
- h. Add the heading "FIRST AID" above the first aid statement.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

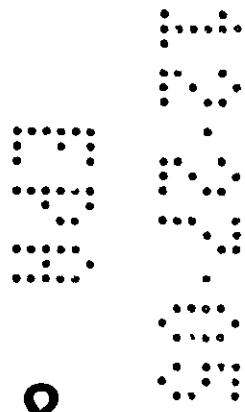

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DOSAGE RATES:

EVERY THREE MONTHS: 16 fl. oz. SEAKLEAR ALGAE PREVENTION & REMOVER per 10,000 gallons pool water (or 500 mL per 40,000 L) will prevent algae growth in all pool types.

SEVERE ALGAE TREATMENT: 32 fl oz SEAKLEAR ALGAE PREVENTION & REMOVER per 10,000 gallons pool water (or 1 Liter per 40,000 L).

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

1. Maintain pool water in the pH range 7.2 to 7.8. Total Alkalinity 80ppm to 120ppm. Adjust pH to 7.2 for severe algae.
 2. Ensure that filtration system is working properly.
 3. Brush pool regularly.
 4. Calculate the volume of SEAKLEAR ALGAE PREVENTION & REMOVER required for your pool.
 5. Add product directly to pool deep end preferably in front of a water return. Dilute in a bucket of pool water when adding to pools with plaster finishes.

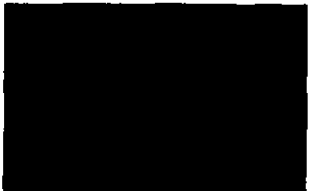
