

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DOSAGE RATES
EVERY THREE MONTHS: 16 fl. oz. SEAKLEAR 90-DAY ALGAE PREVENTION & REMOVER per 10,000 gallons pool water (or 500 mL per 40,000 L) will prevent algae growth in all pool types.

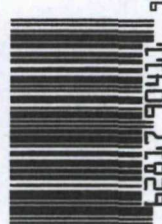
