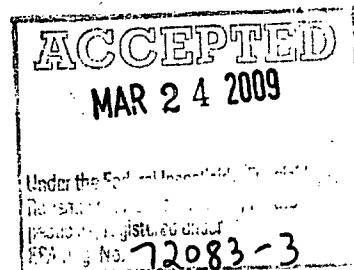

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## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER:** Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing dust or vapors. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wear long sleeved shirt, pants, socks and shoes. Wear chemically resistant gloves such as latex gloves when handling product or opened container. <b>IF SWALLOWED</b>	Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything to an unconscious person.
<b>IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING</b>	Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
<b>IF INHALED</b>	Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
<b>HOTLINE NUMBER</b>	Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. Call 1-800-424-9300 for emergency medical treatment information. For additional emergency information, call the National Pesticides Information Center at 1-800-858-7378, 6:30 AM to 4:30 PM Pacific time (PT), seven days a week. During other times, call the poison control center 1-800-222-1222.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Bromine is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other water unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For further guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of onsite or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep pesticide container closed when not in use. Avoid contact with strong oxidizing agents and other chemicals. Avoid excessive heat.
