Also, add the following statement near the first aid statements: "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment."


EPA recommends that these statements be boxed and bulleted to present the information in a clear, easy-to-read fashion.

- c. Change "Statement of Practical Treatment" to "First Aid".
- d. Revise the statement, "Flea Scare is a mechanical flea killer" to "Flea Scare kills by physical action".
- e. The warranty statement is unacceptable as proposed. Revise it to read, "Manufacturer makes no warranty expressed or implied regarding the performance of this product other than indicated on the label. Buyer assumes all risk of use and/or handling of this material when such use and/or handling is contrary to label instructions".

2. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
