RESTORER may bring old, imbedded oils and soaps to the surface as it dries - simply wipe down with a damp sponge. Regular maintenance with RESTORER will inhibit mold & mildew from returning. TEST IN A HIDDEN AREA FIRST. DO NOT USE ON SUEDE. RESTORER will not stain clothing.


