


Use this product for sanitizing, disinfecting, cleaning and deodorizing on hard, non-porous household surfaces. This product is effective against specific gramnegative germs, such as those causing odors due to bacteria.

**SANITIZING:** Use this product full strength to reduce bacterial contamination by 99.9% on hard, non-porous non-food household surfaces, such as counters, floors, walls, and tubs. Remove gross filth and apply product with a sponge, mop or cloth, thoroughly wetting all surfaces. Let stand 5 minutes. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

**DISINFECTING**: Use 4 oz. of this product to 1 gallon of water to kill gramnegative intestinal bacteria in toilet, sickroom and other hard, non-porous nonfood household surfaces such as floors, walls and tubs (including pet sleeping areas and garbage pails).
