DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use this product for sanitizing, disinfecting, cleaning and deodorizing on hard, non-porous household surfaces. This product is effective against specific gram-negative germs, such as [including] those causing odors due to bacteria.

SANITIZING: Use this product full strength to reduce bacterial contamination by 99.9% on hard, non-porous non-food household surfaces, including counters, floors, walls and tubs. Remove gross filth and apply product with a sponge, mop or cloth, thoroughly wetting all surfaces. Let stand 5 minutes.

DISINFECTING: Use 4 fl. oz. of this product to 1 gallon of water to kill gram-negative intestinal bacteria in sickroom and other hard, non-porous non-food household surfaces including floors, walls, tubs (includes pet sleeping areas and garbage pails) and exterior surfaces of toilets.
