- 3. Add the statement: "Contains Nitrosoamine" to the ingredient statement on the enclosed stamped label.
- 4. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) on EPA Form 8570-4 to reflect the statement at end of formula that reads: "contains a maximum of 0.00022 ppm nitrosamine".
