Section II - Explanation

With this submission, Bayer Advanced is resubmitting a minor label Notification for Merit Concentrate Insecticide II (EPA Reg. No. 72155-51).

The purpose of this Notification is to make the following minor modifications and corrections to the product labeling:

- 1. Added company website address and optional computer graphic to page 2.
- 2. In the Tips for Applying part of the How to Attach and Spray section on page 3, the 1st occurrence of the word "plants" was changed to "area", the 2nd occurrence of the word "plants" was changed to "lawn" since this for use on lawns and not ornamental plants (e.g. shrubs). Also corrected the phrase "both the top and bottom leaf surfaces" in bullet "2" to "lawn".

Enclosed are 3 copies of the product label (two clean copies and one copy with all changes highlighted in yellow).

This notification is consistent with the provision of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

If patches of dead grass appeared in your lawn late last summer, check for grubs. European crane fly larvae often cause damage by feeding on grass roots and disrupting the soil surface.	
	Mole crickets often cause extensive damage by tunneling through lawns. Some species also feed on roots. Tunneling uproots the grass so it easily dries out. Lawns turn yellow, become thin, weedy and can eventually die.
