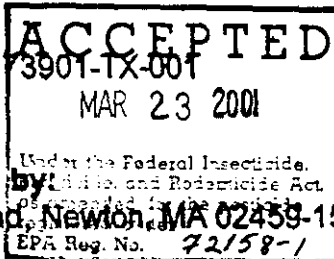

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PredDeter™ Repellent Strips are for use outdoors to reduce the frequency of raccoons, dogs and cats from overturning and upsetting garbage containers. For use in both urban and suburban areas. Use on garbage cans, garbage bags and refuse bins to keep animals from disturbing. PredDeter™ Repellent Strips are also for use in gardens to repel dogs and cats.

To use, remove PredDeter™ Repellent Strips from packaging and separate. Remove paper backing from adhesive side and place strips according to the following rates:

Location	Pest	Number and Placement of PredDeter Repellent Strips
Garbage cans Garbage bags Refuse bins	Raccoons Dogs Cats	Affix strips at equal intervals around the outside of the container six inches from the bottom. Use 4 strips per standard size garbage container (20 gallons). For jumbo garbage cans or large refuse bins (30+ gallons), use up to 6 strips per container. Replace strips when pests return.
Gardens	Dogs Cats	Pound long stakes vertically into the ground at 10-foot intervals around the perimeter of the garden. Stakes already in place for garden fencing may be used in strips will adhere to them. Affix one strip to each stake. Place strips at least six inches about the ground. Replace strips when pests return.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store out of reach of children and pets. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Store in a cool, dry location, away from direct sunlight or heat sources. Do not open or remove from package before ready to use.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap used container in newspaper and discard in trash.
