SUBJECT: Amendment to Label Nations Ag II Chlorothalonil Technical EPA Reg. No. 72167-2 Your Submission Dated January 12, 2007 and Resubmission of March 9, 2007

Dear Dr. Venkatesh:

The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following changes are made:

1. On page 1, in the Note to Physician statement, the word "probably" should be changed to "probable."

2. On page 2, in the For Formulation Purposes Only section, fourth line, item 1, the word "or" should be changed to "of".

3. Delete "municipal parks" because these turf sites are not approved.

4. For cabbage/cole crops and cucurbits, list each crop for which this this product is approved in 40 CFR. Alternatively if the product was approved for each entire crop group, provide evidence and no change is required.

5. Change "may be a potential skin sensitizer" to the standard statement "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."

6. In the warranty statement, add "To the extent consistent with applicable law" before "all such risks...."

Submit one copy of your revised final printed labels within 30 days from the date of this letter.
