3. This registration will expire, without hearing rights on December 28, 2007 unless the Agency receives an amendment to remove the time limitation. Upon receipt of the amendment, the Agency will review all available information and determine whether or not the registration continues to meet the standard for registration. If the Agency determines that the registration does continue to meet the standard for registration, the registrant will be notified and the registration may be amended to remove the expiration. If the Agency determines that the registration no longer meets the standard for registration, the registrant will be notified and the Agency may initiate a Notice of Intent to Cancel or allow the registration to expire.
