


2. The database supporting the registration of this product is currently being re-evaluated. Depending upon the results of this re-evaluation, additional data requirements may be imposed upon this registration. If required, failure to submit acceptable data to fulfill these requirements may result in registration cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e), or in registration expiration as described in paragraph 3 below.

3. This registration will expire, without hearing rights on July 1, 2008 unless the Agency receives an amendment to remove the time limitation. Upon receipt of the amendment, the Agency will review all available information and determine whether or not the registration continues to meet the standard for registration. If the Agency determines that the registration does continue to meet the standard for registration, the registrant will be notified and the registration may be amended to remove the expiration. If the Agency determines that the registration no longer meets the standard for registration, the registrant will be notified and the Agency may initiate a Notice of Intent to Cancel or allow the registration to expire. If additional time is needed beyond the original expiration date to make this determination, the registration may be amended to extend the expiration date to allow adequate time to complete the review of all available information.
