**CSF** Comments

The revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated March 14, 2005, is acceptable and replaces all previous CSFs.

Label Review

The vole efficacy study does not need to be reviewed at this time. Use of voles on the new label is acceptable. Please make the following label changes:

- Sub-label A: Box/Pail Outer Label in Use Restrictions has a typographical error in the third sentence after "...may be used in pars, woodlots..." should be parks.
- For the Non-Urban Areas, include "voles" in the first sentence and delete the "...in beds..." in the second sentence.

Submit one (1) copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

Do not use this product within the occupied habitats of threatened or endangered *Peromyscus* spp. Mice.

**URBAN AREAS:** This product may be used in and around homes, and industrial, commercial and public buildings. This product may also be used in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port or terminal buildings. Applications "around" buildings must be made in tamper-resistant bait stations placed along walls or other external parts of buildings (e.g. doorways, ramps, loading docks) where rats, mice or voles might seek to gain entrance.

Rats: Place at least 2 packs per placement. This package contains enough bait to kill 1 or 2 rats. Space placements at 15-30 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

Rats: Place at least 2-6 packs per placement. This package contains enough bait to kill 3 or 4 rats. Space placements at 15-30 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

2.5 and 25 pounds sizes:}

Rats: Place at least 2-8 packs per placement. Space placements at 15-30 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

**Mice:** Place one pack per placement. Space placements at 8-12 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

Rats and Mice: Immediately replace contaminated or spoiled bait. Properly collect and dispose of all visible dead animals and leftover bait. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment.
