

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This label must be in the user's possession at the time of product application. Apply this product only for the sites, pests and application methods specified on this label.

If sufficient quantities of this bait are ingested, the use of this product kills fleas that commonly infest listed rodent hosts, including *Xenopsylla cheopis*.

Read This Label:

Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. **IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets or other non-target animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

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- 1. Store product not in use in locations out of reach of children and pets.
- 2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and non-target wildlife in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by children under six years of age and dogs, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, other potentially destructive animals or in areas prone to vandalism.
- 3. Dispose of product container as well as unused, spoiled and unconsumed bait, as specified on this label.

Tamper-resistant bait stations must be used if children, pets, non-target mammals or birds have access to bait.

RATS AND MICE

Use Restrictions: Use this product to kill only Norway Rats [(*Rattus norvegicus*)], Roof Rats [(*Rattus rattus*)] and House Mice [(*Mus musculus*) and their infested fleas, in and around non-residential building, industrial/agricultural buildings and similar man-made structure, and inside transport vehicles. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come into direct contact with food. Do not use in edible product areas of feed processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not contaminate food/feed or food/feed-handling equipment or place near or inside ventilation duct openings. Do not use this product to control listed species within the occupied habitats of threatened or endangered species. Wear gloves when handling bait or animal carcasses. Do not apply farther than 50 feet from buildings. Do not sell this product in individual containers holding less than 4 pounds of bait.

Selection of Treatment Areas: Determine areas where rodents will most likely find and consume bait. Generally, these areas will be along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors or walls, beside burrow openings and other locations where signs of rodents have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

Application Directions:

Norway Rats and Roof Rats: Apply 4 to 16 one-ounce bait blocks per bait placement. Space placements at intervals of 15 to 30 feet in infested area. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days of until there no longer are signs of new feeding by rats.

House Mice: Apply 1 one-ounce bait block per placement. Space bait placements at intervals of 8 to 12 feet in infested area. At points of extremely high mouse activity use 2 blocks. Maintain an uninterrubted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until fresh signs of feeding by house mice cease to appear.

Follow-up (Rats & Mice): Immediately replace contaminated or spoiled bait. While wearing gloves, properly collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of redent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of reinfestation is present, establish permanent bait stations. Regularly check the stations and replace bait as needed.

VOLES

Use Restrictions: Use this product to kill only meadow voles [(*Microtus pennsylvanicus*)], pine voles [(*M. pinetus*)] and montane voles [(*M. montaus*)] and their infested fleas, around (usually within 15 feet of) homes, and industrial, commercial, agricultural and similar man-made structures. Do not use this product to control listed species within the occupied habitats of threatened or endangered species. All bait applications must be made by hand. Wear gloves when handling bait or animal carcasses. Do not apply farther than 50 feet from buildings. Do not sell this product in individual containers holding less than 4 pounds of bait.

Selection of Treatment Areas: Determine areas near buildings where voles or signs of vole activity (girdling of plants, consumption of bulbs, burrow openings and surface runways) have been seen. These areas generally will be in flower beds or under shrubs, bushes or ground cover.

Application Directions: Place 1 one-ounce bait block in each bait station. Situate bait stations near runways, burrow openings or plants that voles have been damaging. Check placements daily. Remove any fouled or spoiled bait and replenish if vole activity and interest in bait persist. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until

there no longer are signs of vole activity and feeding on bait. While wearing gloves, properly collect and dispose of any carcasses and leftover bait.

Follow-up: At the end of the control program dispose of carcasses and any uneaten bait.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **Container Disposal:** Non-refillable container; do not reuse or refill this container.
