- 1. In your "Storage and Disposal" section, delete "or, if allowed ... out of smoke). after "by incineration".
- 2. Under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals", add the following paragraph after "shoes and gloves":

USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining personal protective equipment (PPE). If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

- 3. Place your "FIRST AID" and "Note to Physician or Veterinarian" texts under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals".
- 4. Under "LIMITATION OF LIABILILITY", delete the 3rd Paragraph ("USES WITH ... specifically recommended.") as this product is never tank mixed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This label must be in the user's possession at the time of application of this product. Apply this product only for the sites, pests and application methods specified on this label.

Read this Label:

Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets or other domestic animals to this product. To help prevent accidents:

- 1. Store product not in use in locations out of reach of children, pets and other animals.
- Keep pets and livestock out of treated areas until bait has been consumed by the rodents.
- Dispose of product container, unused, spoiled or unconsumed bait as directed on this label.

Use Restrictions: Use this product to aid in the reduction of flea populations on squirrels of the Genus Spermophilus and prairie dogs of the Genus Cynomys in parks, golf courses, rangeland, pasture, alfalfa, wheat, oats, barley, fruit tree orchards (dormant season only), non-crop rights-of-way and other non-crop areas. The insecticide in this product acts systemically to aid in the reduction of fleas that commonly infest listed rodents including *Oropsylla idahoensis*, *O. hirsute* and *Hoplopsyllus anomalus*. Apply this product only at times of year when these rodents are readily accepting grains. Bait at a time when rain is not expected for at least four days after the time of baiting. Do not apply bait over roads, walkways or water.

Wear gloves when applying bait. With detergent and hot water, wash all utensils used for applying bait. Do not use these utensils for mixing, holding or transferring foods or feeds.

Baiting: Manually scatter 1/2 cup of bait (approximately 2 ounces or 56 grams) on ground near each burrow opening being used by ground squirrels or prairie dogs. Bait spoons, measuring cups or other suitable implements may be used to measure and distribute bait. Re-apply bait to the same area every other day for 3 to 4 applications. Do not pile the bait; scattering the bait allows the rodents to utilize their natural foraging behavior and limits exposure to livestock and non-target wildlife.

A continuous supply of bait is needed for 6 to 8 days to ensure that all ground squirrels or prairie dogs present have an opportunity to feed on bait for at least 5 consecutive days. Do not exceed the maximum application rate of ½ cup per burrow for 4 applications.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **Container Disposal:** Non-refillable container; do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available, or reconditioning, if appropriate; otherwise, dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill; or by incineration; or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning (if burned, stay out of smoke).
