It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This label must be in the user's possession at the time of application of this product.

Apply this product only for the sites, pests and application methods specified on this label.

Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets or other domestic animals to this product. To help prevent accidents:

- 1. Store product not in use in locations out of reach of children, pets and other animals.
- 2. Keep pets and livestock out of treated areas until bait has been consumed by the rodents.
- 3. Dispose of product container, unused, spoiled or unconsumed bait as directed on this label.

Use Restrictions: Use this product to aid in the reduction of flea populations on squirrels of the Genus *Spermophilus* and prairie dogs of the Genus *Cynomys* in parks, golf courses, rangeland, pasture, alfalfa, wheat, oats, barley, fruit tree orchards (dormant season only), non-crop rights-of-way and other non-crop areas. The insecticide in this product acts systemically to aid in the reduction of fleas that commonly infest listed rodents including *Oropsylla idahoensis*, *O. hirsute* and *Hoplopsyllus anomalus*. Apply this product only at times of year when these rodents are readily accepting grains. Bait at a time when rain is not expected for at least four days after the time of baiting. Do not apply bait over roads, walkways or water.

Wear gloves when applying bait. With detergent and hot water, wash all utensils used for applying bait. Do not use these utensils for mixing, holding or transferring foods or feeds.

Baiting: Manually scatter 1/2 cup of bait (approximately 2 ounces or 56 grams) on ground near each burrow opening being used by ground squirrels or prairie dogs. Bait spoons, measuring cups or other suitable implements may be used to measure and distribute bait. Re-apply bait to the same area every other day for 3-4 applications. Do not pile the bait; scattering the bait allows the rodents to utilize their natural foraging behavior and limits exposure to livestock and non-target wildlife.

A continuous supply of bait is needed for 6 to 8 days to ensure that all ground squirrels or prairie dogs present have an opportunity to feed on bait for at least 5 consecutive days. Do not exceed the maximum rate of ½ cup per application and four applications per burrow.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Bait spoons, measuring cups or other suitable implements may be used to measure and distribute bait. Use a mechanical spreader to broadcast bait on areas less than 10 acres in size. Re-apply bait to the same area every other day for 3 to 4 applications. Do not pile the bait; scattering the bait allows the rodents to utilize their natural foraging behavior and limits exposure to livestock and non-target wildlife.

A continuous supply of bait is needed for 6 to 8 days to ensure that all field rodents present have an opportunity to feed on bait for at least 5 consecutive days.
