DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read this Label: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. Use only for sites, pests and application methods described on this label.

Important: Do not expose children, pets or other domestic animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children, pets and other animals.
2. Apply this product in secured, tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be constructed and used in ways which prevent such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. Stations must be

secured so that they cannot be overturned by young children, pets, or winds. Stations used in areas open to livestock and/or non-target wildlife must be secured so that the units cannot be readily overturned by any non-target animals that have access to them.

3. Dispose of product container, unused, spoiled or unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

Use Restrictions: This product can only be used to control California ground squirrels (*Spermophilus beecheyi*) in and within 100 feet of man-made structures constructed in a manner so as to be vulnerable to commensal rodent invasions and/or to harboring or attracting rodent infestations. Examples of such structures include homes and other permanent or temporary residences, food processing facilities, industrial and commercial buildings, trash receptacles, agricultural and public buildings, transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft), docks and port of terminal buildings and related structures around and associated with these sites. Fence and perimeter baiting, beyond 100 feet from a structure as defined above, is prohibited. This product must not be applied directly to food or feed crops. The insecticide in this product may act systemically to aid in the reduction of fleas that infest California ground squirrels. The types of fleas that might be controlled include, but are not necessarily limited to, *Oropsylla montana* and *Hoplopyllus anomalus*. Use only for the sites, pests and application methods described on this label. Do not broadcast this product. Do not sell this product in individual containers holding less than 4 pounds of bait.

Application Directions: Secure bait stations at locations where they will be readily accessible to California ground squirrels, preferably near active burrows. Secure stations 20 to 100 feet apart, depending upon density of the population. Wear waterproof gloves and use a long handled scooping device to transfer bait from the container to the station. Use 2 to 4 pounds of bait per station.

Check bait stations frequently to insure that an uninterrupted supply of bait is always available for at least 15 days, or until there no longer are any signs of feeding.

Post-Application Directions: Wearing waterproof gloves, collect and bury dead rodents. Dispose of leftover bait according to "Pesticide Disposal". With detergent and hot water, wash all implements used for applying bait. Do not use these implements for mixing, holding, or transferring foods or feed.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **Container Handling:** Non-Refillable Container; do not reuse or refill this container. {Plastic buckets;} Offer for recycling or reconditioning; or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill; or by incineration. {Plastic/Paper Bags;} Completely empty bag, then offer for recycling, if available; otherwise, dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration.
