VI. LABEL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A. Reviewers should only accept draft labeling for review that meets the following requirements:

1. Submissions for new registrations or amendments must include five copies of all draft labeling (typescript or mock-up). For all amendments, one copy of the draft proposed label should be marked up or annotated in some way, such as Redline/Strikeout, to indicate what has been changed. The other three copies should be "clean" or not annotated in any way, but include all label changes for which the amendment is submitted.

2. All copies must be legible and of suitable quality for making legible photocopies. Draft labeling must have print size of at least 12 characters per inch to aid in label review and to ensure that additional photocopies will be legible.

3. All labeling should be submitted on $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper or mounted on $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper.

B. If the labeling submitted by the registrant does not meet the above criteria, discontinue the label review. Go to chapter four to open and close out the registration action. Send a letter to the registrant describing the submission deficiencies.

If the above label submissions are not followed, the submission is subject to rejection.


3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record before the product is released for shipment.
