Prior to using this shampoo on your pet, please perform a patch test to ensure your pet does not have any sensitivities to the pesticide used in this shampoo. Apply a small amount of shampoo on a small section of your pet's fur, allow the lather to penetrate the fur for five minutes before rinsing. Wait 48 hours and observe your pet for any allergic reaction.

Wet pet's coat thoroughly with warm water. Starting at the head and working back, work up a lather with this quick lathering formula, being sure that the lather is worked thoroughly into pet's coat down to skin. Allow lather to stand five minutes, then rinse completely with clean water and towel dry. Supervise pet during use and do not allow pet to lick coat while the shampoo is on. To maintain maximum effectiveness against both fleas and ticks, repeat (or reapply) every week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Keep this product in its tightly closed original container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and animals.

Container Disposal: If empty: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
